

Religious Education – Lent/Easter Activities

Pick some of these activities to support our learning in Religious Education.

Holy Week

Create a comic strip which outlines the events of Holy Week.

- Palm Sunday
 Maundy Thursday (this could include the Last Supper, washing of the feet and Jesus' arrest)
 - Good Friday
 - Easter Sunday

Jerusalem Times

Create a newspaper report about the death of Jesus.

Use John 19: 16-42 to make notes on the events.

Ensure you write about the key facts and events, including the feelings and experiences felt.

The raising of Lazarus

In John 11:1-43, we hear about Jesus visiting friends, a journey which ends in death and resurrection.

Read the scripture and create an interview with some of the eyewitnesses. Who? What? Where? How?

Get baking!

Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty." John 6:35

Bake some bread and discuss the meaning of the bread of life e.g. mould, rise, shape, feed etc.

Paschal Candle

Research what the Paschal Candle is and what is written on it.

Create a poster with an image and annotate the meanings of the inscriptions.

You can then design your own!

Easter Vigil

The Easter Vigil takes place on Holy Saturday night, as late as possible. It is a celebration of Jesus' new life and his resurrection.

Plan a collective worship with this theme.

Remember: Gather, Listen, Respond and Mission.
